Hats of students!! Well done!!



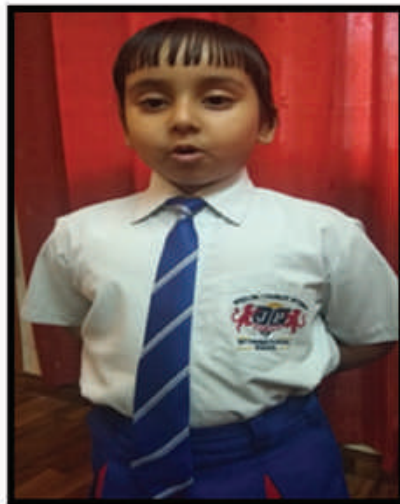

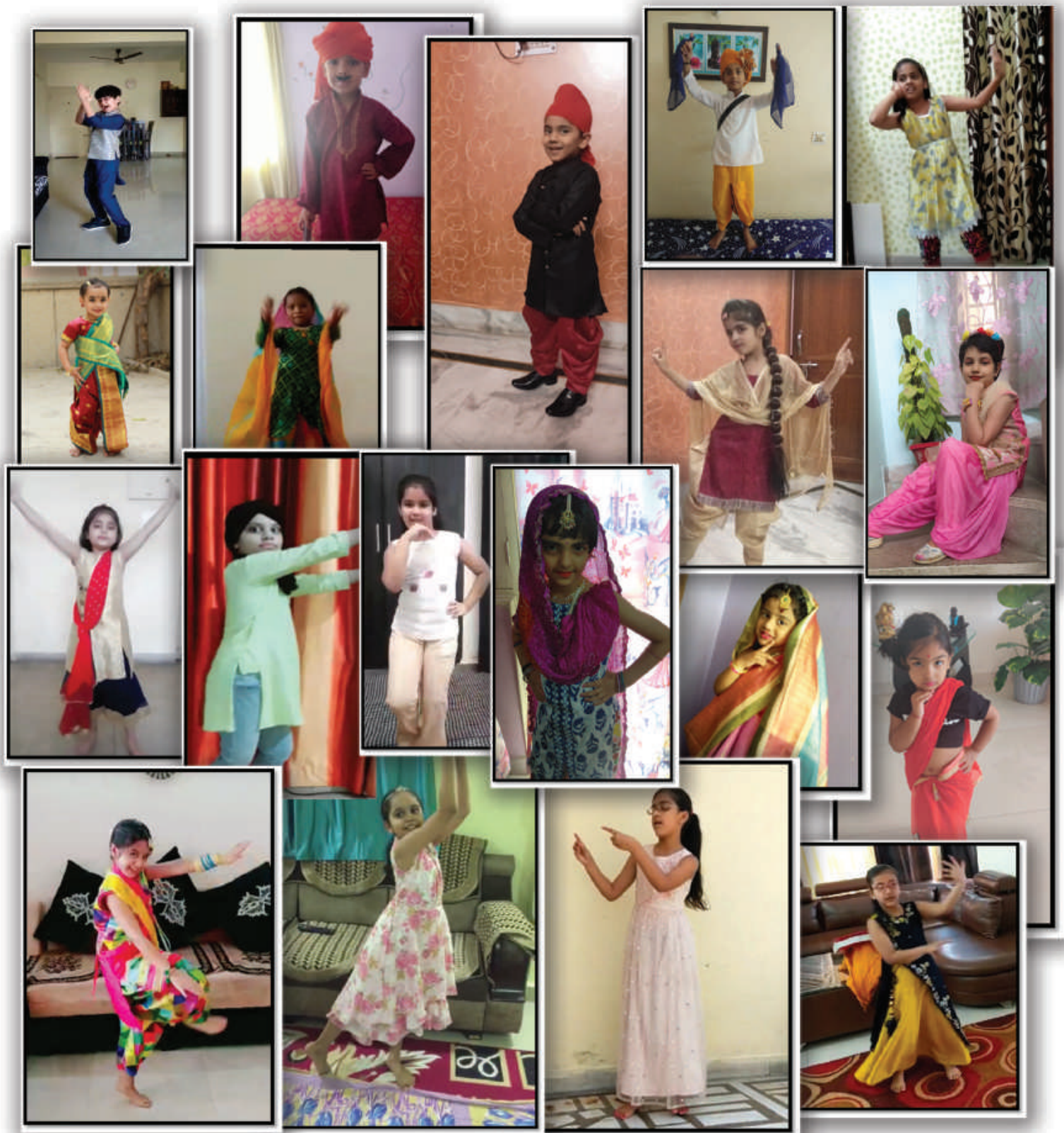
"Harvesting the fruits of your previous year's hard work – is the core essence of Baisakhi Festival."

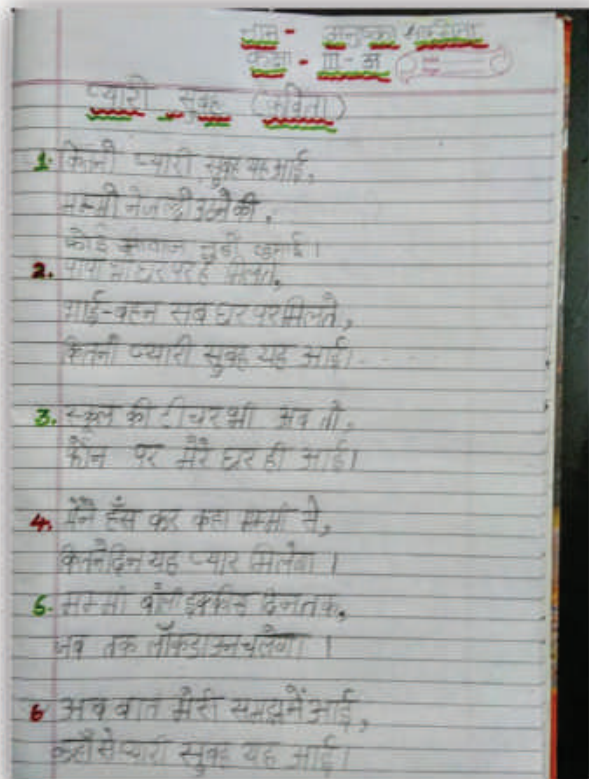
