








BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION




STORYTELLING






HOW TO BECOME CS?

JP International School organized an insightful session on ' How to become a company secretary' for Grade XI & XII on 7th August 2021.



Krishna Janmashtami is celebrated as the birthday of Lord Krishna, one of the most powerful and famous reincarnations of Lord Vishnu.


