Several motivational and guiding videos were shown to acquaint them to give a wholesome and enriching learning experience to their students. Teachers were also made familiar to the usage of Mentimeter and Padlet as an alternative technology for better assessment of students. Overall it was an enriching and knowledgeable workshop for teachers which will help them in their professional as well as individual growth. Jolly Phonics is a Multisensory approach to teach Phonics to children which helps them to improve their reading and writing skills.

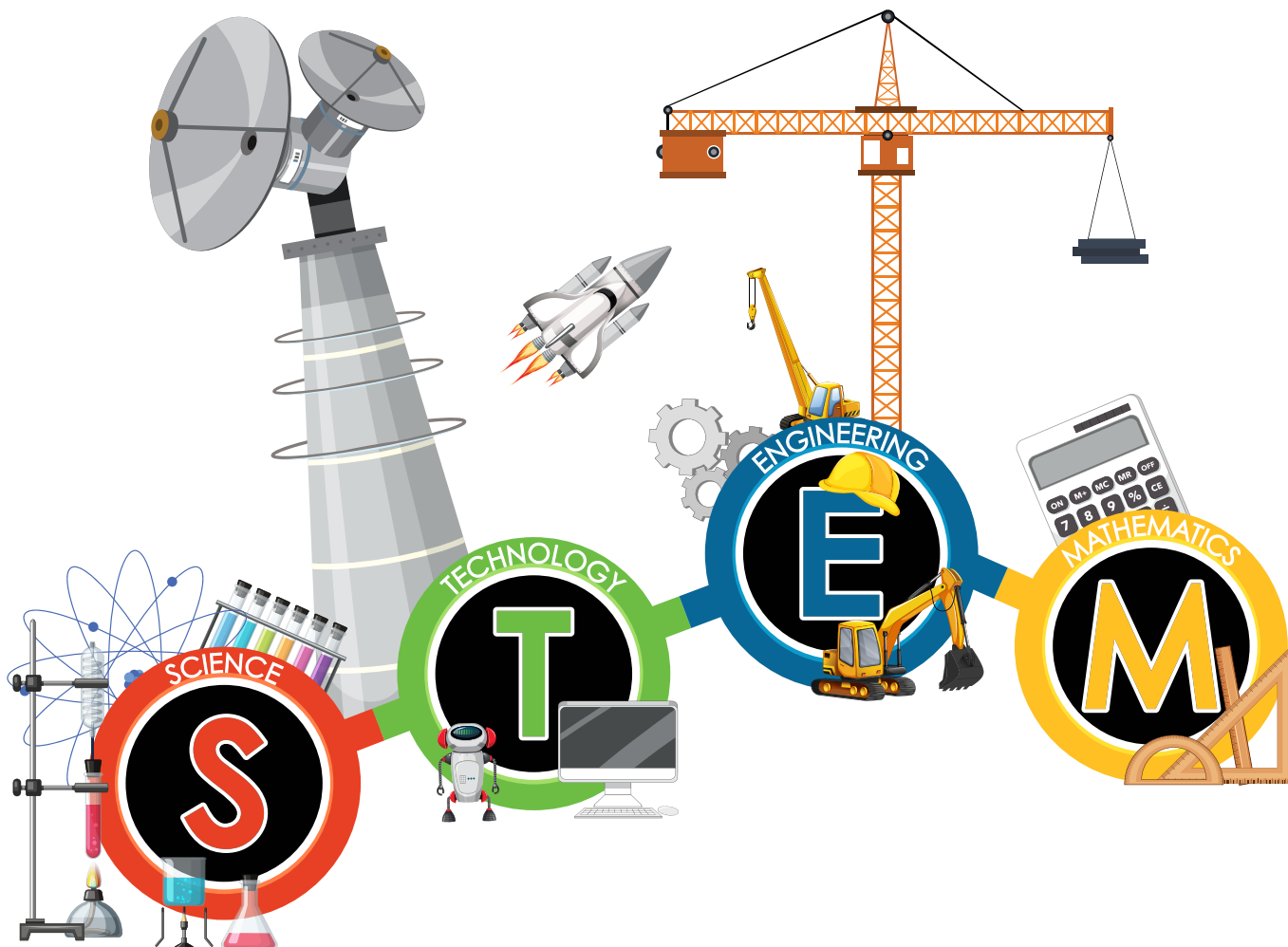

The focus area of the workshop was Language Skills like learning the letter sound, learning letter formation, blending, and segmenting, identifying sounds in a word, tricky words, and spelling rules.

The session was very interactive and effective. It was beautifully exemplified how sounds are required to be taught in classroom setting, emphasized the techniques of introduction of sounds in the class. The workshop was packed with teaching aids such as flashcards, soft toys, PPT, videos, pictures, and study material. Ms. Shefali gave multiple ideas of activities that can be conducted in the classroom and gave hands-on learning experiences to the teachers to focus on the approach to make the little ones learn.

"The role of the teacher is to create the conditions for invention rather than provide ready-made knowledge."

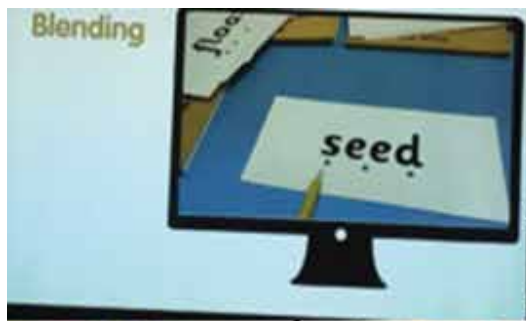
This is exactly what STEM education focuses on!

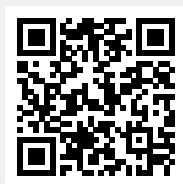
