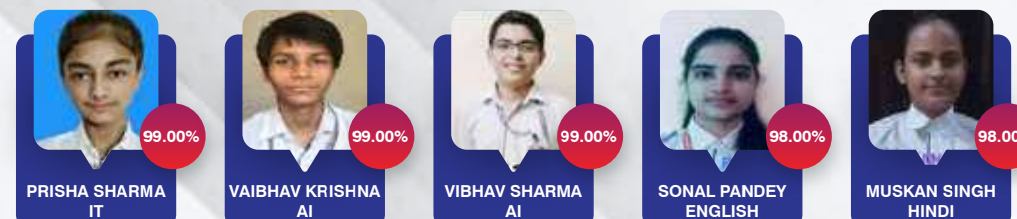
FOR THE EXCELLENT RESULTS IN CLASS X EXAMINATION 2022.

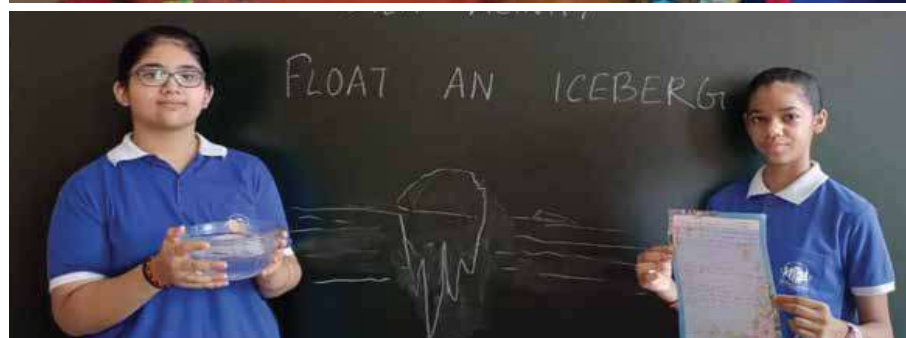
Innovation distinguishes between a leader and a follower – Steve Jobs

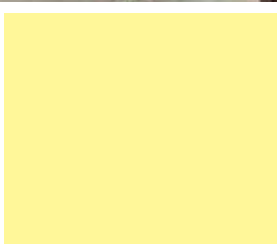


DADI MAA KA PITARA

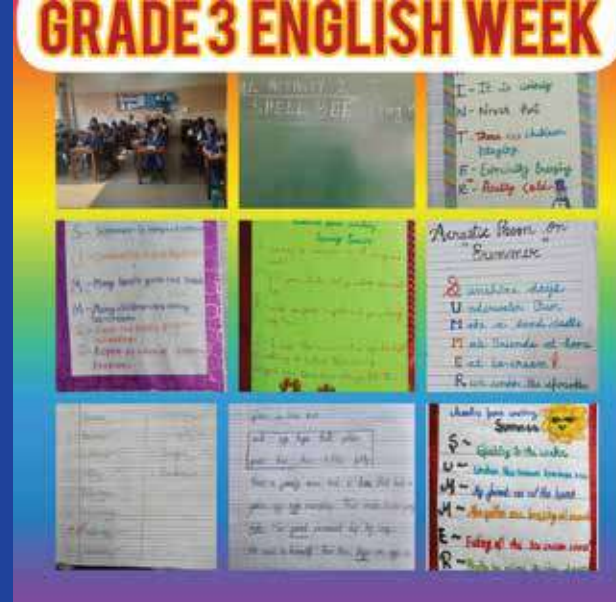


CELEBRATIONS LIBRARY WEEK

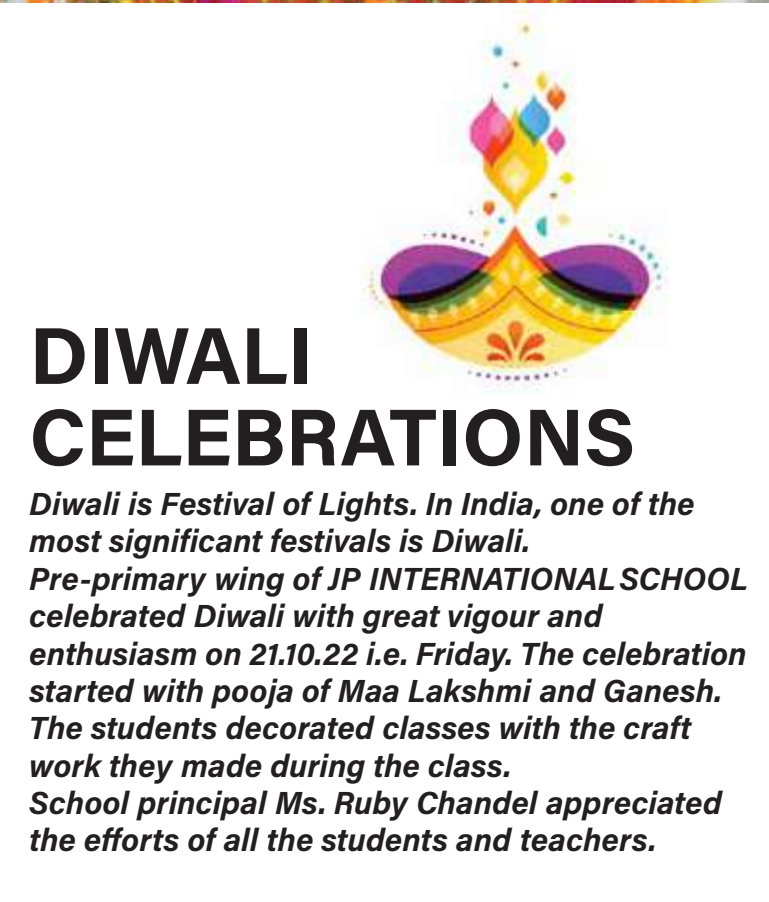
NAVRATRI AND DUSSHERA CELEBRATIONS

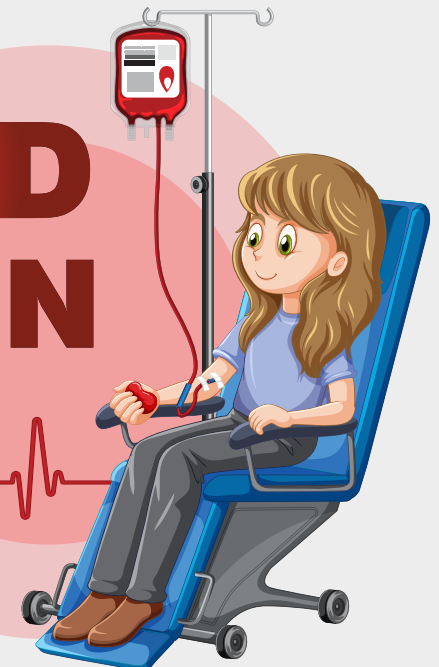

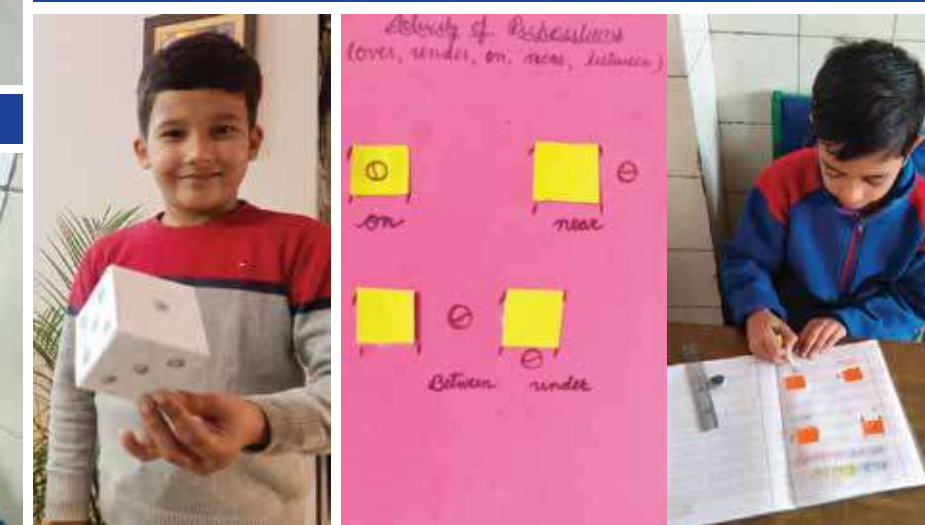

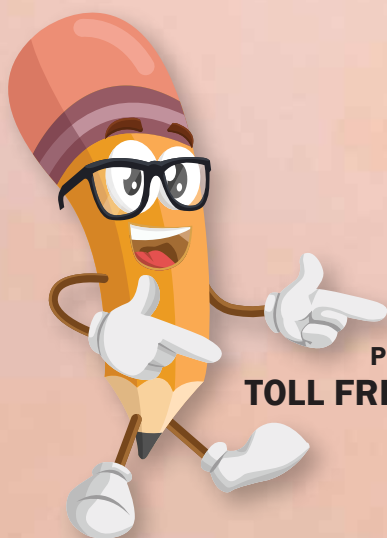
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
