**Benesse in India**

Khojo Assessments	Assessments to be conducted for students in <b>Grade 8,9,10 (Math and Science)</b> along with <b>Learning Habits and Self Reflection</b> to identify student's learning gaps and address those gaps post analysis of the reason why such gaps exist. The assessments would be conducted <b>twice in a year (1<sup>st</sup> Assessment- July and 2<sup>nd</sup> Assessment- Oct/Nov)</b> and would be conducted across two consecutive dates	<b>10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11<sup>th</sup> July 2023</b>
Digital workbook:	Personalised for each student, in line with his/her areas of weakness. This is a repository of <b>130 questions and solutions</b> for students to practice. <b>Digital Workbook</b> would be provided post each cycle of the assessments for both Math and Science	<b>1<sup>st</sup> week of September</b>
Detailed Student Report	This will have <b>cross-analyses of Subject performance + Learning Habits of the student</b> . Student's weaker areas will be highlighted, and student will be prompted to practice these topics from the Digital Workbook (linked to the Student Report via a QR code)	<b>1<sup>st</sup> week of September</b>
Comprehensive Teacher Report	This will be a <b>comprehensive report providing an overview of the performance of the school as well as performance of each class</b> – teachers will therefore be able to view a trend of how her/his class / school has performed and what are the overarching focus / strong areas and learning habits of the students	<b>1<sup>st</sup> week of September</b>
Digital access to 'Keybo' platform	<b>All assessments + reports + practice tests + digital workbooks</b> will be available here as a one-stop portal, via Login ID and Password.  Teachers + Management will have Admin Access for the school, while Students + Parents will be able to access their individual page	<b>1<sup>st</sup> week of September</b>
Specific sessions for students	Goal setting and Career Awareness sessions to help students plan their academic journey better	<b>3<sup>rd</sup> week of September (tentative)</b>
Khojo Mentorship Programme	This is an optional programme that is expected to commence from <b>June 2023 and continue until March 2024</b> .	<b>1<sup>st</sup> week of June (tentative)</b>
Certification	Certificate of participation to each child	<b>March'24 post completion of both the cycle of assessments</b>
