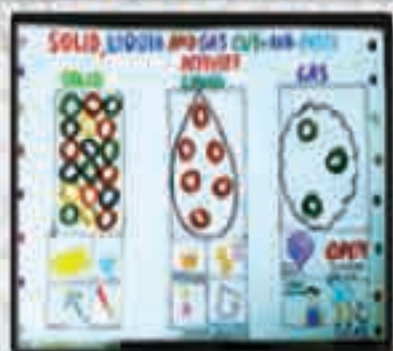
## Molecular Arrangement

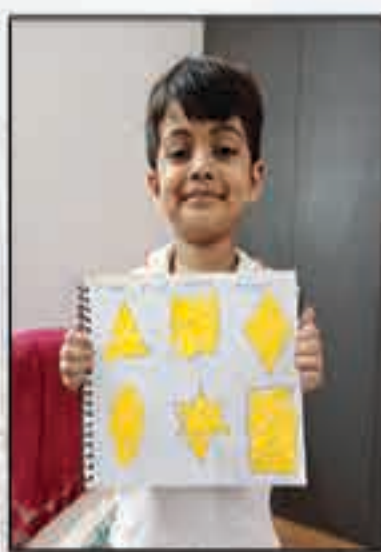
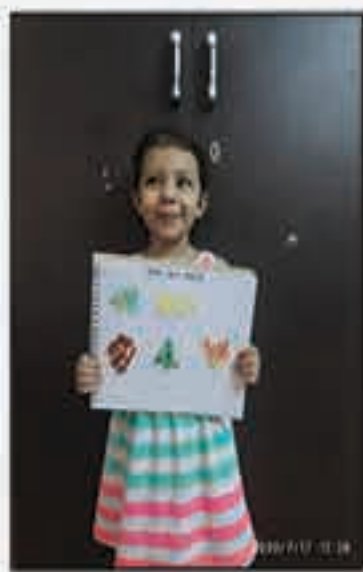
**Concept:** Shapes around us\*

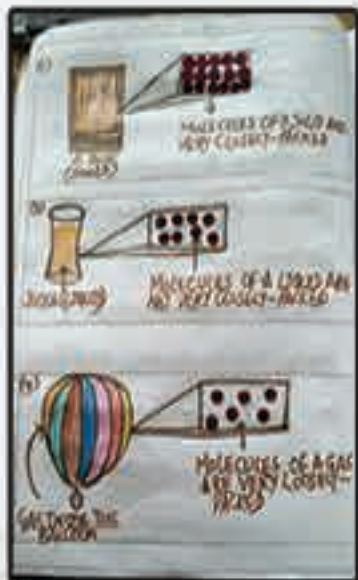

**Description-** The students were able to describe the water cycle in their own words. They understood the rain is the main source of water and how water cycle is important for all living things.



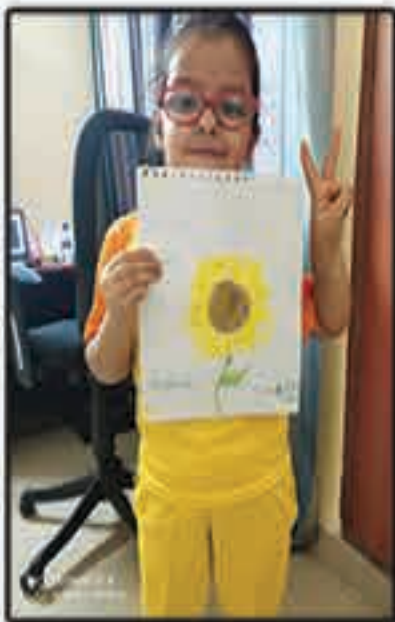

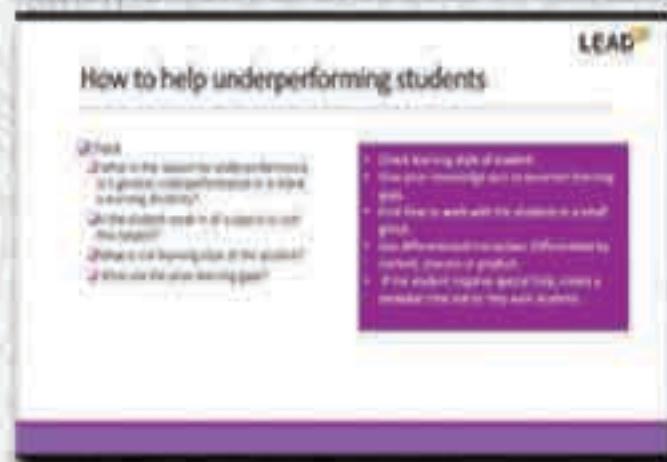
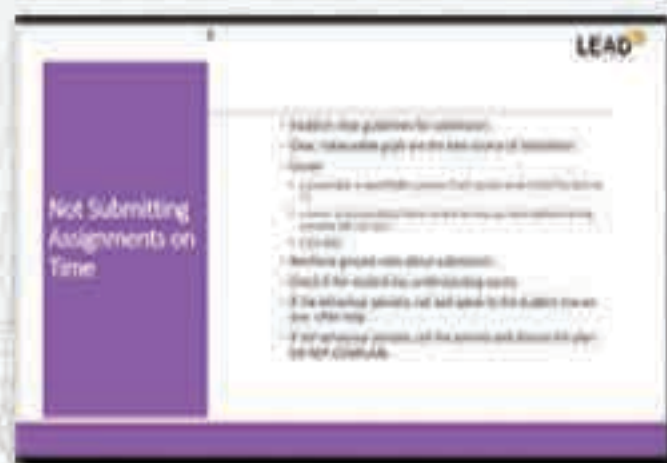
## Training Session
